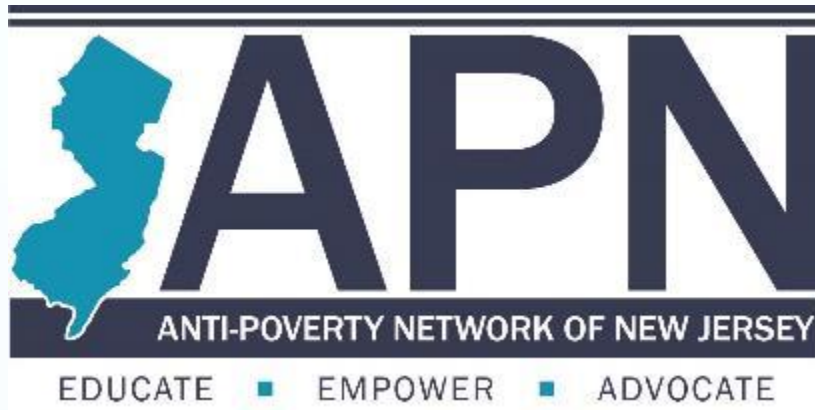
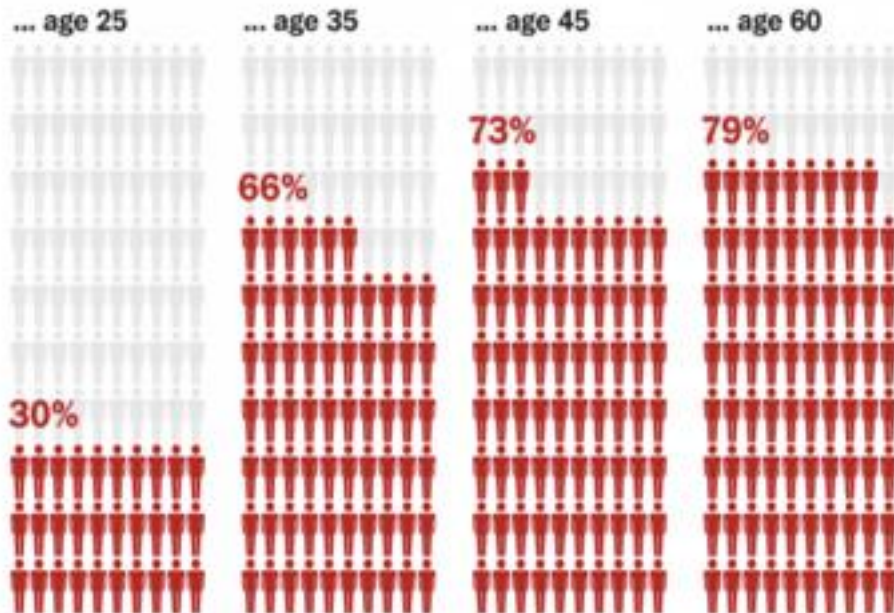

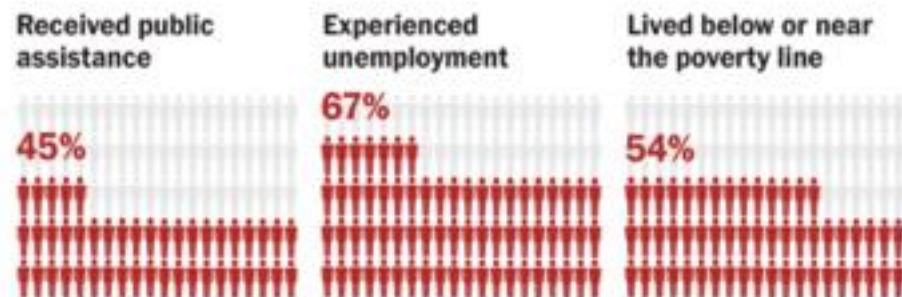


# Economic hardship: surprisingly common
